Make Music with Friends

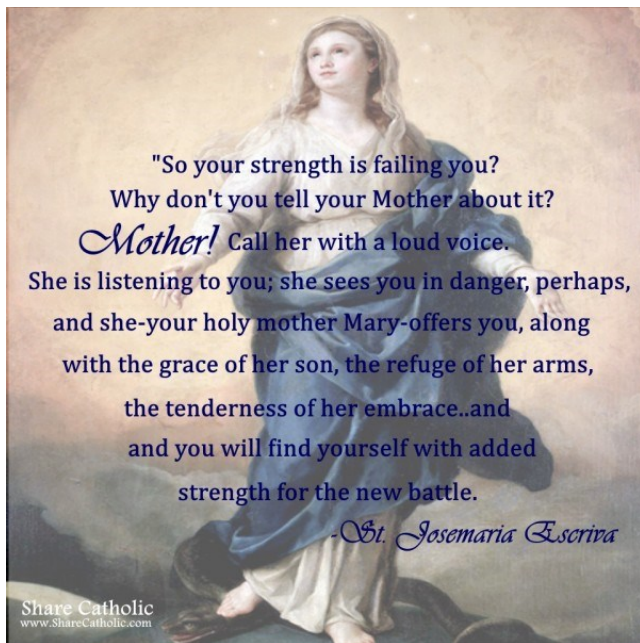
Do you play a musical instrument and like meeting interesting people? Enjoy the spontaneous musical collaboration of a Jam Session!

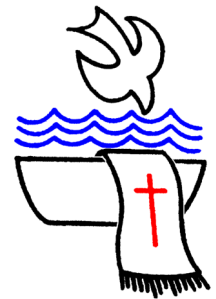
Wednesday, May 18 at 7pm - Prep Class in the Parish Hall
