### SACRAMENTS OF CONFIRMATION AND FIRST HOLY EUCAHRIST

The sacraments of Confirmation and First Holy Eucharist are celebrated together in the Archdiocese of Regina for all children in Grade 2 or older. The preparation for these sacraments will take place in the Church, in the school and in the child’s home. 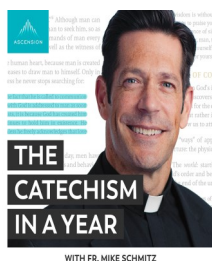
