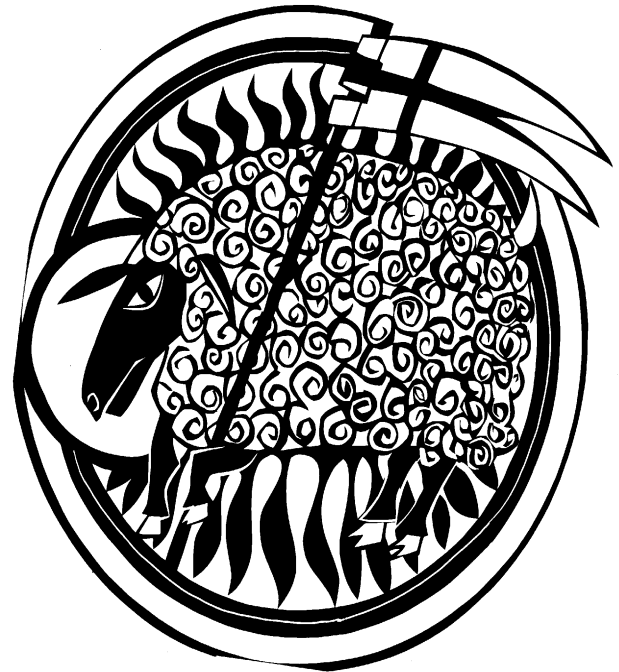

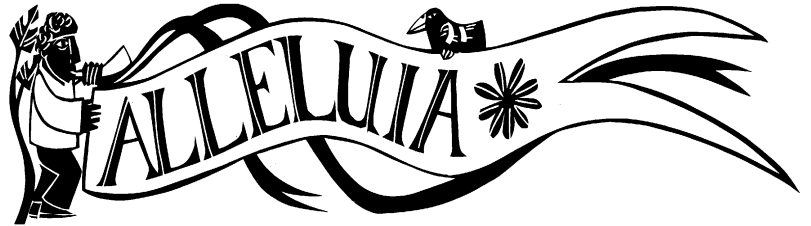

## **Gifts of the Holy Spirit**

### **Humility - Romans 12:3**

For by the grace given to me I say to everyone among you not to think of yourself more highly than you ought to think, but to think with sober judgement, each according to the measure of faith that God has assigned.

### **Wisdom - 1 Corinthians 2:6-7**

Yet among the mature we do speak wisdom, though it is not a wisdom of this age or of the rulers of this age, who are doomed to perish. But we speak God's wisdom, secret and hidden, which God decreed before the ages for our glory.

### **Ministry - 1 Corinthians 4:1**

Think of us in this way, as servants of Christ and stewards of God's mysteries.

### **Love - 1 Corinthians 13: 4-7**

Love is patient; love is kind; love is not envious or boastful or arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice in wrongdoing, but rejoices in the truth. It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

### **Faith - 2 Corinthians 4:16**

So we do not lose heart. Even though our outer nature is wasting away, our inner nature is being renewed day by day.

### **Fortitude - 2 Corinthians 4:1**

Therefore, since it is by God's mercy that we are engaged in this ministry, we do not lose heart.

### **Holiness - 2 Corinthians 7:1**

Since we have these promises, be loved, let us cleanse ourselves from every defilement of body and of spirit, making holiness perfect in the fear of God.

## **Gifts of the Holy Spirit**

### **Endurance - James 1:12**

Blessed is anyone who endures temptation. Such as a one has stood the test and will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him.

### **Generosity - James 1:17**

Every generous act of giving, with every perfect gift, is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change.

### **Wisdom - James 3:17**

But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceful, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without a trace of partiality or hypocrisy.

### **Patience - James 5:7**

Be patient, therefore, beloved until the coming of the Lord. The farmer waits for the precious crop from the earth, being patient with it until it receives the early and the late rains.

### **Holiness - 1 Peter 1:13**

Therefore prepare your minds for action; discipline yourselves; set all your hope on the grace that Jesus Christ will bring you when he is revealed.

### **Hope - 1 Peter 1:3**

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! By his great mercy he has given us a new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

### **Chosen - 1 Peter 2:9**

But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's own people in order that you may proclaim the mighty acts of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.

### **Love - Romans 12:9-10**

Let love be genuine; hate what is evil, hold fast to what is good; love one another with mutual affection; outdo one another in showing honor.
