


May God continue to bless you to continue with and expand on all of the Parish's good work as you welcome a Pastor who is so passionate for God and the Church.

### BAPTISM

"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you." —Matthew 28:19-20a



Your child's baptism is a time for celebration and joy. We want to help you plan and prepare for the baptism in the best possible way. We offer our Baptism Prep sessions three times per year. Our first session will begin in September. The next sessions will begin in January and May.

Each session includes three classes on Monday evenings, the Presentation of the Parents during a Sunday Holy Mass and the Baptism Celebration following a Sunday Holy Mass.

Please call the Parish Office to register for one of the Baptism Preparation Sessions. And remember you must attend all classes and Holy Masses during the session you choose.

### RECONCILIATION

The sacrament of reconciliation is available thirty minutes before the weekday Holy Masses. You may also call the Parish Office to book a time to receive this sacrament. During Advent and Lent, we offer an evening of Adoration and Reconciliation. Watch the parish bulletin for more information.

#### FIRST RECONCILIATION

Our First Reconciliation Preparation is offered to our children who are in grade 3 or older. The sessions will begin in September with a Parents' Meeting. We then have an Enrolment Mass, six classes, a retreat and the Celebration sometime in early December.

You are required to attend all the Prep Sessions. If you would like to register your child to receive these sacraments, please call the Parish Office.

### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING


"Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord." —James 5:14
