We are offering two sessions:

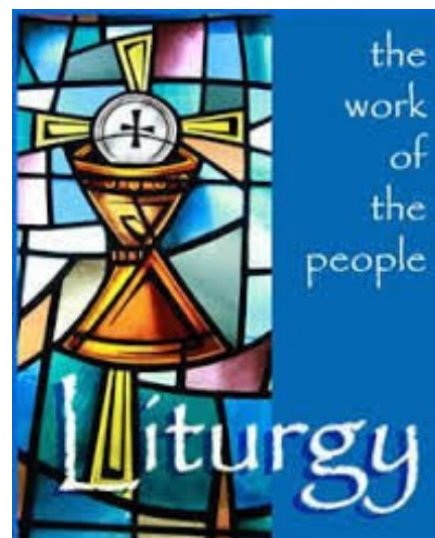
Tuesday, June 11 following the 7pm Holy Mass

Faith Formation and Evangelization

Faith Formation – to help build personal relationship with the Holy Trinity - God our Father, Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit.

Evangelization – to be a disciple and take God the Father, Jesus Christ our Brother and the Holy Spirit out into the world.

Theme – June is the month of Father’s Day and the Celebration of our Patron Saint John the Baptist

“Happy Father’s Day”

**Truth** – spend some time with God Our Father this month. Hold your Bible in your hands with reverence. While holding your Bible, pray from your whole heart that you may be guided to whatever God wants you to be led to right now. Then after a few minutes of prayer open the Bible and read whatever your eyes focus on first. A friend of mine calls this “Bible Roulette.” Now spend some time with what you have read and prayed for then ask God why this message? Why now? Remember to be gentle to yourself, if nothing strikes you right away that’s okay you have time, be patient and loving to yourself with God’s message. He wants that for you.

1. His feast day is June 24<sup>th</sup>. This day was chosen as it is six months before the birth of Christ. With its proximity to the summer solstice, it signifies the waning of the light.
2. Survived several assassination attempts brought on by his rigorous reforms, particularly in the defence of the rights of the Church against secular powers. He died in 1134.
3. At age 15 he joined the Canons Regular of Saint Augustine. Then joined the Franciscans and was sent by St. Francis to preach and teach his fellow friars. His aid is invoked to help find lost objects.
4. A bishop of Lyons and in the direct line of the disciples. His most important contribution was his assertion that creation is not sinful by nature, but rather distorted by sin.
5. The first Ukrainian Catholic bishop of Canada. He came to Canada in 1912 to ensure the stability and growth of Ukrainian Catholic parishes and schools. He returned to Europe in 1927 and in 1945 he was arrested and exiled to Siberia, where he died a martyr’s death in 1949.
6. Retired to a life of solitude in a cave to write commentaries and hymns. He was the first to introduce hymns into public worship. Called the “Harp of the Holy Spirit.”
7. He is a patron of lawyers, statesmen and politicians. He was an enlightened man, he insisted that his three daughters receive the same education as his son. Thomas was imprisoned in the Tower of London then beheaded at age 57, (about 1534) claiming to be “the King’s good servant, but God’s first.”
