

Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Weekend of August 6/7, 2016

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus concludes his teaching about those who are "faithful and prudent stewards" with that classic stewardship teaching: "Much will be required of the person entrusted with much, and still more will be demanded of the person entrusted with more." Christian stewards recognize that God is the ultimate source of their gifts, talents, resources and aptitudes, and that God wants them to use these varied gifts in his service. This week might be a good time to reflect on our God-given gifts. Are we using those gifts to serve the Lord? If Christ came back to us unexpectedly tomorrow would we be able to give a full accounting of how we have exercised stewardship over these gifts?

Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time Weekend of August 13/14, 2016

In today's second reading, we hear the author of the letter to the Hebrews liken the daily life of the Christian steward to a race, a long-distance race perhaps, certainly not a sprint; requiring endurance and a single-minded focus on Jesus at the finish line. Good stewards are firmly committed to running the race, to live the Christian life to the fullest, to keep their eyes focused on Jesus. They don't grow weary. They don't lose heart. They know there is immense joy waiting for them at the finish line. Are you fully committed to living each day for Christ? Are you running the race, or are you simply jogging? Just walking? Sitting? Going backwards? Going nowhere? Some of us may want to reflect on what we can do to run the race with even more conviction. Others may want to reflect on how to simply enter the race and start running.

Update on Community Center - A special meeting, open to all parishioners, will be held on Tuesday, August 23 from 7 p.m. to 8 p.m. in the auditorium to discuss the proposal recommended from the Finance Council regarding the sale of the Community Center.

Immediately after the meeting the Pastoral Council will meet to discuss the information presented and will make a recommendation to the Finance Council.

Update on Community Center: After receiving the recommendations of both the Pastoral Council and the Finance Council, the Archbishop's Office has given permission for the parish to solicit proposals to sell the Community Center. Over the past 12 years, the Community Center has been costing the parish at least \$35,000 to \$40,000/year (not including major repairs and upgrades). Also, over the past 12 years, the Community Center has been under-utilized when it comes to using it to serve the Church's mission and purpose. Moreover, over the past year and a half, the operating funds available to the parish have decreased by about \$70,000 due to the following situations: a) the loss of over \$20,000/year at the Community Center due to the implementation of the updated leasing and rental policies of the Archdiocese; b) the decrease in Sunday collections for 2015 of about \$24,000 due to the economic downturn; and c) we are anticipating an additional decrease in Sunday collections of at least \$25,000 for 2016 due to the economic downturn. (This will put the Sunday collections at the 2009 level.) The Finance Council will guide the process for obtaining proposals to sell the Community Center. Once the proposals have been obtained, the Finance Council will review the information and make a recommendation. The recommendation will then be reviewed by the Pastoral Council.
