Update on Community Center: After receiving the recommendations of both the Pastoral Council and the Finance Council, the Archbishop's Office has given permission for the parish to solicit proposals to sell the Community Center. Over the past 12 years, the Community Center has been costing the parish at least \$35,000 to \$40,000/year (not including major repairs and upgrades). Also, over the past 12 years, the Community Center has been under-utilized when it comes to using it to serve the Church's mission and purpose. Moreover, over the past year and a half, the operating funds available to the parish have decreased by about \$70,000 due to the following situations: a) the loss of over \$20,000/year at the Community Center due to the implementation of the updated leasing and rental policies of the Archdiocese; b) the decrease in Sunday collections for 2015 of about \$24,000 due to the economic downturn; and c) we are anticipating an additional decrease in Sunday collections of at least \$25,000 for 2016 due to the economic downturn. (This will put the Sunday collections at the 2009 level.) The Finance Council will guide the process for obtaining proposals to sell the Community Center. Once the proposals have been obtained, the Finance Council will review the information and make a recommendation. The recommendation will then be reviewed by the Pastoral Council. Once a final decision is made by the Finance Council, the recommendation will be submitted to the Archbishop's Office to review and to decide whether or not to proceed with the possible sale of the Community Center.
