

PARISH FINANCIAL UPDATE

Currently our Parish has a deficit of -\$57,400.29.

We had budgeted our 2018 Sunday Collections to be \$385,000.00, at the end of **September** our collections total \$274,236.03. To reach our budgeted goal we will need an

additional \$110,763.97 + \$20,000. for the Youth Minister's salary that was not included at budget time. To reach our budget goals we will need over \$43,000 /month for the next 3 months.
