The Archdiocese of Regina has restored the order of the Sacraments of Initiation.

The Sacraments of Initiation are:

Baptism - we share in his death and resurrection. Confirmation - we share in the gift of the Pentecost. Communion - we share in the food of life.

Once again this year at St. John the Baptist Parish, Grade Two candidates will receive both the sacrament of Confirmation and the sacrament of First Communion at the same celebration. The preparation for these sacraments will take place in the Church, in the school and in the child's home. Preparation will begin in the fall and continue throughout the school year. (Over the past few years, Archbishop Daniel Bohan has clearly stated that the practice of celebrating First Communion before Confirmation is no longer an option in the Archdiocese of Regina.)
