

#### **Pastoral Care Ministry**

Our team has grown to include many ministers. We vary in age and gifts but together we are so grateful for the blessings we receive through our Pastoral Care Ministry. We offer regular training workshops and welcome anyone who feels a call to serve our parish in this way.

#### **Senior Care Ministry**

We have been blessed with the opportunity to provide ministry in all of our senior care facilities. Communion services are celebrated every week in each home with Holy Mass at the chapel at St. Joseph's Hospital on a weekly basis. We celebrate Holy Mass in each care home once a month. We also provide a Word of God Liturgy with Communion twice a month at Mainprize Manor in Midale.

#### **Home Communion Ministry**

We are working to expand our Pastoral Care Ministry to serve all in need. Our ministry team is available to provide home communion to those who are not able to attend mass due to physical or other limitations. Offering Holy Communion in our senior Parishioners homes is a key piece to our goal serving everyone in our Parish Family. If you or someone in your family would like a minister to provide home communion please let us know.

#### **Prayer Shawl Ministry**

We are fortunate to have gifted ministers who are willing to give their time to pray as they knit or crochet beautiful prayer shawls. These shawls are filled with the love of faithful people and are available to anyone experiencing sickness or preparing for surgery. #### **Blessed Meals**

Our Blessed Meals Team prepares and delivers a hot meal to our senior parishioners throughout the city twice a month. We are serving 70 meals each delivery. Their Ministry brings much joy to those who receive and those who prepare it.

## **Sacrament of Baptism**

## Sacraments of First Reconciliation/ Confirmation/First Holy Eucharist

These Sacraments are celebrated together in May or June each year. Registration for the Sacrament Prep for First Reconciliation, Confirmation and First Holy Eucharist begins in January. This is open to children in Grade 2 and up.

## Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist

Holy Mass is celebrated throughout the week and on the weekends. Please check a current bulletin for the schedule.

#### Sacrament of Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is celebrated 30 minutes before each weekday and weekend Holy Mass. Please call or text Father Thuy if you would like to receive this sacrament prior to Holy Mass.


## **Sacrament of Marriage**

To register for sacrament prep, you must be a registered parishioner of St. John the Baptist Parish. Please contact the Parish Office for more information.






### **Finance Council**


## **Knights of Columbus**


### Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph December 29, 2024
