

Pastoral Care Ministry

Our team has grown to include many ministers. We vary in age and gifts but together we are so grateful for the blessings we receive through our Pastoral Care Ministry. We offer regular training workshops and welcome any one who feels a call to serve our parish in this way.

Senior Care Ministry

We have been blessed with the opportunity to provide ministry in all of our senior care facilities. Communion services are celebrated every week in each home with Holy Mass returning to the chapel at St. Joseph's Hospital on a weekly basis. We celebrate Holy Mass in each care home once a month. In the spring we were invited to begin a Care Ministry at the Midale Senior Care Home twice a month. We have made new friends and are enjoying the gift that each of our seniors give us through their unfailing faith. We truly receive more than we give .

Home Communion Ministry

We are working to expand our Pastoral Care Ministry to serve all in need. Our ministry team is available to provide home communion to those who are not able to attend mass due to physical or other limitations. Sacraments At St. John the Baptist Parish

Sacrament of Baptism

We look forward to celebrating this first sacrament for your child with your family. Baptism Prep is held three time per year in our Parish.

Sacraments of Confirmation/First Holy Eucharist

These sacraments are celebrated together in May or June each year. Registration for the sacrament prep for Confirmation/First Holy Eucharist happens in January. This is open to children in Grade 2 and up.

Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist

Holy Mass is celebrated throughout the week and on the weekends. Please check a current bulletin for the schedule.

Sacrament First Reconciliation

The Prep for this Sacrament of healing begins in the Fall of each year and is open to children in Grade 3 and up.

Sacrament of Reconciliation

The sacrament of Reconciliation is celebrated 30 minutes before each weekday Holy Mass.

Sacrament of Marriage

Contact the Pastor by calling the Parish Office eight months prior to your wedding. Please note that the Church will not be reserved for you until you have had the initial meeting with Father Antony.

Sacrament of Anointing

The sacrament of anointing is offered after each Holy Mass during the seasons of Lent and Advent. For anointing in your home, please contact the Parish Office to set up a date and time. In the case of emergency, the sacrament of Anointing is available at any time. During Office hours, please contact the Parish Office. After Office hours, please contact Connie at 306-421-8447.




