The Joy of the Resurrection

Christ is risen! Alleluia!

These are not just words we shout once a year—they are the very foundation of our faith.

The Resurrection of Jesus Christ is the central mystery of our Christian life.

As St. Paul proclaims, *“If Christ has not been raised, our preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain”* (1 Cor 15:14). But He **has** been raised. Death has been conquered. Sin has been defeated. Love has triumphed.

And this changes everything.

The Resurrection is not just an event of the past. It is **a living reality**—a power that breaks into our lives **today**, offering healing for our wounds, hope for our despair, and light for every darkness.

To believe in the Risen Lord is not merely to say “Alleluia.”

It is to live as people who have encountered Him.

It is to allow His victory to reshape how we think, how we love, how we forgive, and how we lead others.

This Easter season, I invite you to let the joy of the Resurrection **transform you from within**.

Leave behind the tombs of fear, bitterness, and old habits.

Let Christ roll away the stones in your heart and **walk out with you into newness of life**.

But don't stop there.

The angel at the empty tomb said, *“Go, and tell the disciples.”*

The joy of Easter is not meant to be kept, but **shared**.

So I challenge you:

Tell someone about the hope you've found in Jesus.

Invite someone back to Mass.

Show mercy where there's been resentment.

Be patient where there's been division.

Let the Risen Christ live not only in our churches,
but in our words, our witness, our welcome.

Bring the light of the Resurrection to those who still sit in doubt,
to those trapped in despair,
to those who have lost faith in life itself.

Let them see, through you:

Christ is truly risen. And that changes everything.

Alleluia.

DAY 4 (Easter Monday) - Those who do not believe in Jesus & those who do not know Him

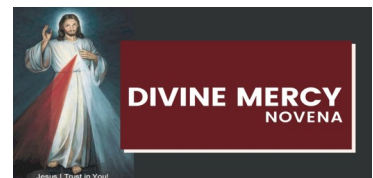
DAY 5 (Easter Tuesday) - The souls of separated brethren
