


Lenten Reconciliation and Adoration Evening

Please consider temporary or ongoing coverage for Eucharistic Adoration Wednesday 2-3pm and Friday 1-2pm.



SACRAMENTS OF CONFIRMATION AND FIRST HOLY EUCAHRIST
