

SACRAMENTS OF CONFIRMATION AND FIRST HOLY EUCAHRIST

The Catechism of the Catholic Church on Lent

- By the solemn forty days of *Lent* the Church unites herself each year to the mystery of Jesus in the desert. CCC 540
- The seasons and days of penance in the course of the liturgical year (Lent, and each Friday in memory of the death of the Lord) are intense moments in the Church's penitential practice. These are particularly appropriate for spiritual exercises, penitential liturgies, pilgimages as signs of penance, voluntary self-denial such as fasting and almsgiving, and fraternal sharing (charitable and missionary works).
