

SACRAMENTS OF CONFIRMATION AND FIRST HOLY EUCAHRIST

The sacraments of Confirmation and First Holy Eucharist are celebrated together in the Archdiocese of Regina for all children in Grade 2 or older. The preparation for these sacraments will take place in the Church, in the school and in the child's home. Registration forms have been sent out through the Catholic schools and they are also available at the entrances of the Church, at the Parish Office and on our website (stjohnthebaptistestevan.ca)

The children do not attend these meetings, it is only for the parents. Both meetings will be held in the Parish Hall. This meeting will give you an outline of the year of preparation ahead.



The Catechism of the Catholic Church on Lent

- By the solemn forty days of *Lent* the Church unites herself each year to the mystery of Jesus in the desert. CCC 540
- The seasons and days of penance in the course of the liturgical year (Lent, and each Friday in memory of the death of the Lord) are intense moments in the Church's penitential practice. These are particularly appropriate for spiritual exercises, penitential liturgies, pilgrimages as signs of penance, voluntary self-denial such as fasting and almsgiving, and fraternal sharing (charitable and missionary works).
