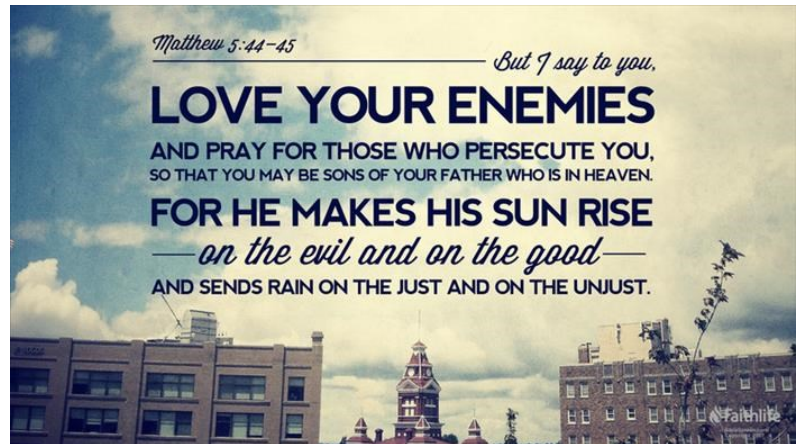

We also have extra workbooks available if you are unable to attend the Study, but would like to still take part. Workbooks can be picked up at the Parish Office for \$40.

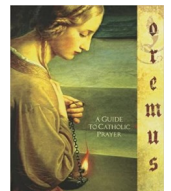


St. John the Baptist Parish AGM
