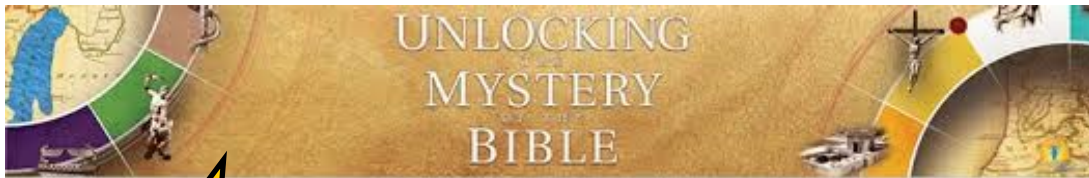
Unlocking The Mystery Of The Bible!
