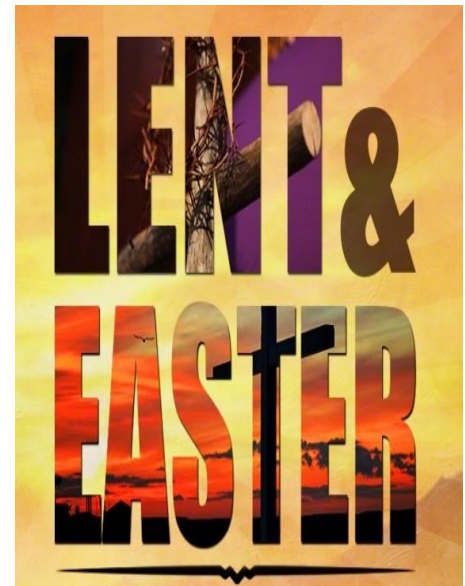

Thursday, March 21 - Session Four: Responding To God's Call

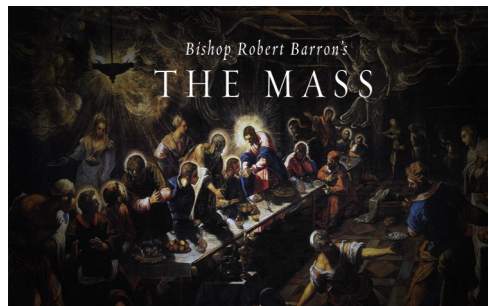
Thursday, March 28 - Session Five: Preparing For Sacrifice
