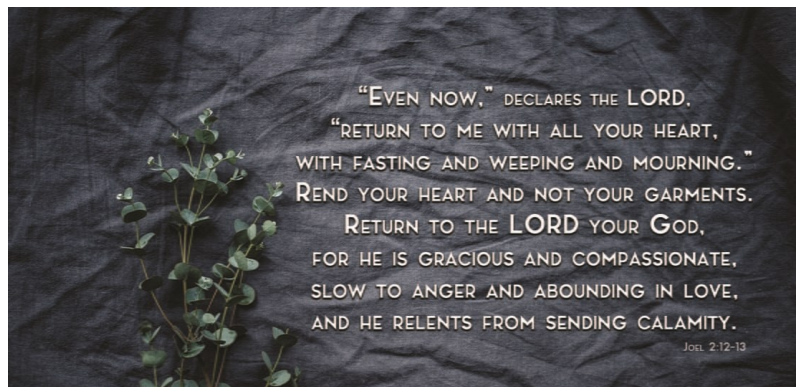
Guided Holy Hour



Giving Alms



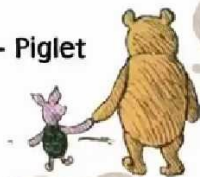
