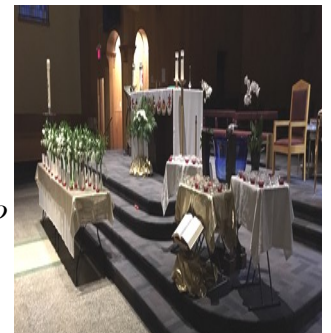


**St. John the Baptist Parish will be offering an All Souls' Day Holy Mass on Saturday, November 2 at 7pm.**
