First Reconciliation



If your child is in Grade Three or older, they are invited to join us for First Reconciliation Preparation. Registration forms have been sent though the Catholic schools and need to be returned to the school by Friday, September 28. If your child attends a public school, registration forms are available at the Main Entrance of the Church

The First Reconciliation Parents' Meeting will be on Tuesday, October 9. We will begin with Holy Mass at 7pm with the meeting to follow in the Church Auditorium. A parent must attend this meeting. The children are not required to attend; this meeting is just for the parents. You will be given an outline of the year of preparation we have planned.

CONFIRMATION/FIRST EUCHARIST PREPARATION

Once again this year at St. John the Baptist Parish, Grade Two and above candidates will receive both the sacrament of Confirmation and the sacrament of First Eucharist at the same celebration. PARISH FINANCIAL UPDATE

Currently our Parish has a deficit of -\$60,184.24.

We had budgeted our 2018 Sunday Collections to be \$385,000.00, at the end of August our collections total \$235,785.08. To reach our budgeted goal we will need an

additional \$149,214.92 + \$20,000. for the Youth Coordinator's salary that was not included at budget time. To reach our budget goals we will need over \$42,000 /month for the next 4 months.
