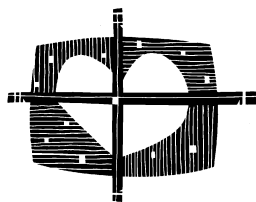

GRADE TWO CONFIRMATION/FIRST COMMUNION

“And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. This promise is for you, for your children, and for all who are far away. It is for everyone the Lord our God calls to himself.”

The Archdiocese of Regina has restored the order of the Sacraments of Initiation.

The Sacraments of Initiation are:

Baptism - we share in his death and resurrection.

Confirmation - we share in the gift of the Pentecost.

Communion - we share in the food of life.

Once again this year at St. John the Baptist Parish, Grade Two candidates will receive both the sacrament of Confirmation and the sacrament of First Communion at the same celebration. The preparation for these sacraments will take place in the Church, in the school and in the child’s home. Preparation will begin in the fall and continue throughout the school year.



Registration forms will be sent through the Catholic schools soon. If your child attends a public school, please call Connie at the Parish Office to register. ***There will be a Parents’ Meeting on Tuesday, September 26 at 6:30pm in the Church Auditorium.*** This meeting will give you an outline of the year of preparation ahead.
