Dear parishioners,

Saturday, September 14 is the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. Early in the 4th century, St. Helena, mother of the Roman Emperor

Constantine, went to Jerusalem in search of the holy places of Christ's life. She razed the second-century Temple of Aphrodite, which tradition held was built over the Savior's tomb, and her son built the Basilica of the Holy Sepulcher on that spot. During the excavation, workers found three crosses. Legend has it that the one on which Jesus died was identified when its touch healed a dying woman. One third of the cross remains in the Basilica of the Holy Sepulcher and the rest of the wood was then distributed to churches throughout the region so all could venerate the cross.

Today, the cruelty of the cross is not what is exalted, but the Love that God manifested to humanity by accepting death on the Cross. "Who, though in the form of God, emptied himself, taking the form of a slave. This is the glory of the Cross of Jesus!" (Pope Francis)

This week, I encourage you to really look at a cross that you have at home and pay attention to the crosses you see in our community. When you look at the cross, what one word comes to mind?

God of Glory, the cross shines as a sign of obedience to your will and a symbol of your love for the world. Bless us who find salvation in the cross of Christ; may we always recognise his glory in the weak, suffering and condemned of the world. I ask this through Christ, crucified and exalted, who is Lord forever and ever. Amen.

Unlocking the Mystery of the Bible

Growing in Faith Study

Many Catholics want to read the Bible but get bogged down by the long stretches that seem not to make sense or get lost among the sea of Old Testament names and places.
