### **Third Sunday of Advent**

In today's second reading Paul concludes his letter to the Christian community at Thessalonica by providing it with actions to take as its members wait for the return of the Lord. Prayerful stewards rejoice and give thanks in all circumstances because they are people of hope. A good reflection this week would be how the season of Advent can give you reason to hope.



Sunday Liturgy of the Word: Training for those who wish to minister to their parishes in the capacity of leading Lay Services or helping.


Funeral Vigil Prayer Leaders: Training for those who wish to serve their parishes in this ministry.
