



## The Catholic Women's League of Canada Scholarship Sponsored by St. John the Baptist, Estevan Council

**Value of Scholarship** – Maximum of 2 - \$1,000 scholarships payable on completion of Semester I and confirmation of Semester II attendance at an institute of higher learning.

**Eligibility** – Any Catholic Grade XII student of the Estevan Comprehensive School (ECS).

**Requirements:**

1. Student must be completing Grade XII in the current academic year.
2. Student must be planning to attend a post-secondary institution, either academic or vocational.
3. The student must be a practicing Catholic.
4. Scholarship will be presented on proof of completion of Semester I and continued attendance in Semester II. Student must attend the post-secondary school in either the first or second semester of the year following graduation. (If circumstances change and the recipient is unable to attend the post-secondary school during the year following graduation, he/she is asked to notify the CWL before October 1 so that the scholarship may be awarded to an alternate applicant).
5. A recommendation from the current principal or classroom teacher **must** accompany the application form.

**Condition of the Award**

1. Ongoing identification with **PARISH VOLUNTEER LIFE** throughout his/her years at **ECS**.
2. Volunteer in various Parish and Community activities, be they extra-curricular, intramural, or athletic. (Attach)
3. Academic standing (at least 70% average)
4. A positive attitude toward classroom instruction, classmates and projects undertaken by the school and/or parish.
5. Attach a copy of your Semester I final grades **and** Semester II midterm grades.
